SESSION 1: LIVING THE DASH --- Play the Teaching Clip

“So teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom.”
Psalm 90:12

Psalm 90 is the only Psalm Moses wrote in the entire Book of Psalms. Yet it is as applicable today than when he first wrote it. We are not sure when he wrote it but we do know that God called him when he was 80 years old to lead the massive Exodus of the Hebrew from slavery to freedom. Moses maximized the dash! From faithfully confronting Pharaoh, putting his staff into the Dead Sea believing God would part it, to investing in Joshua to take the lead one day.

There is nothing more sobering to life than to be with someone who knows her days are numbered. There is often an authenticity that fills the room. Much like everyday living, some choose bitterness and distance themselves from others while others are intentional about spending valuable moments with those they love. How would you live differently if you knew you only had 40 days to live?

Read Psalm 90: 1-12 slowly, almost like a prayer.
